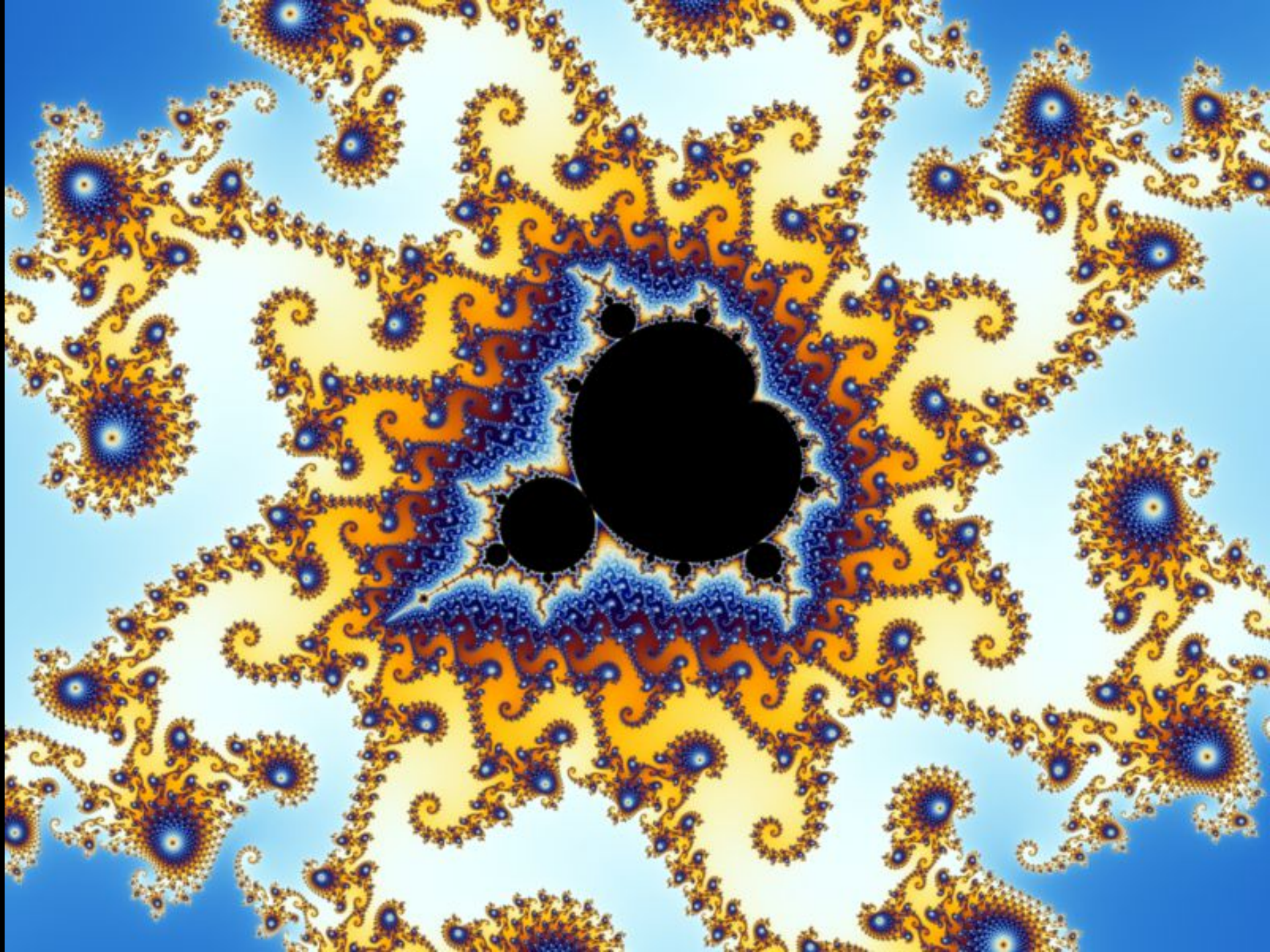


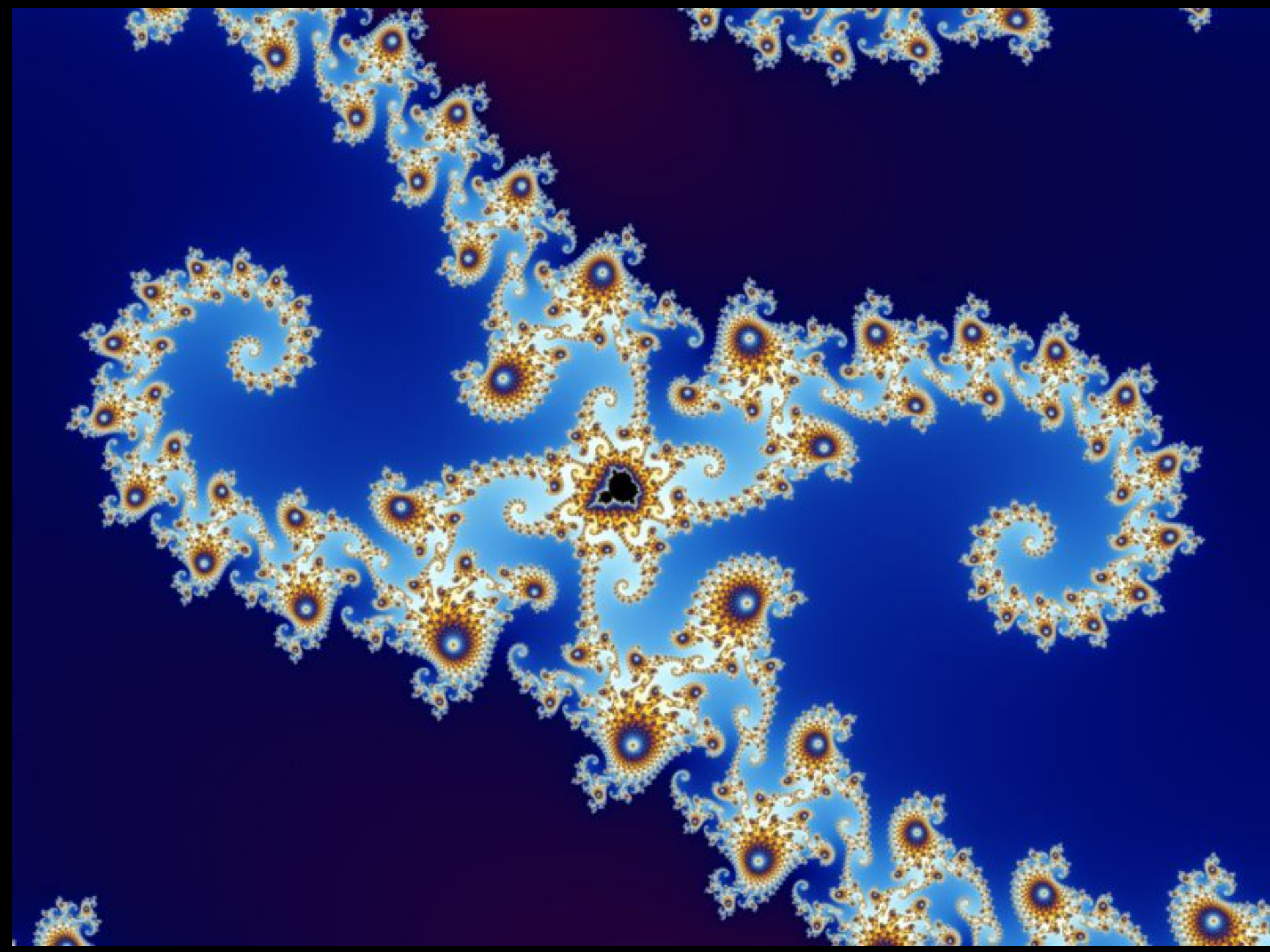




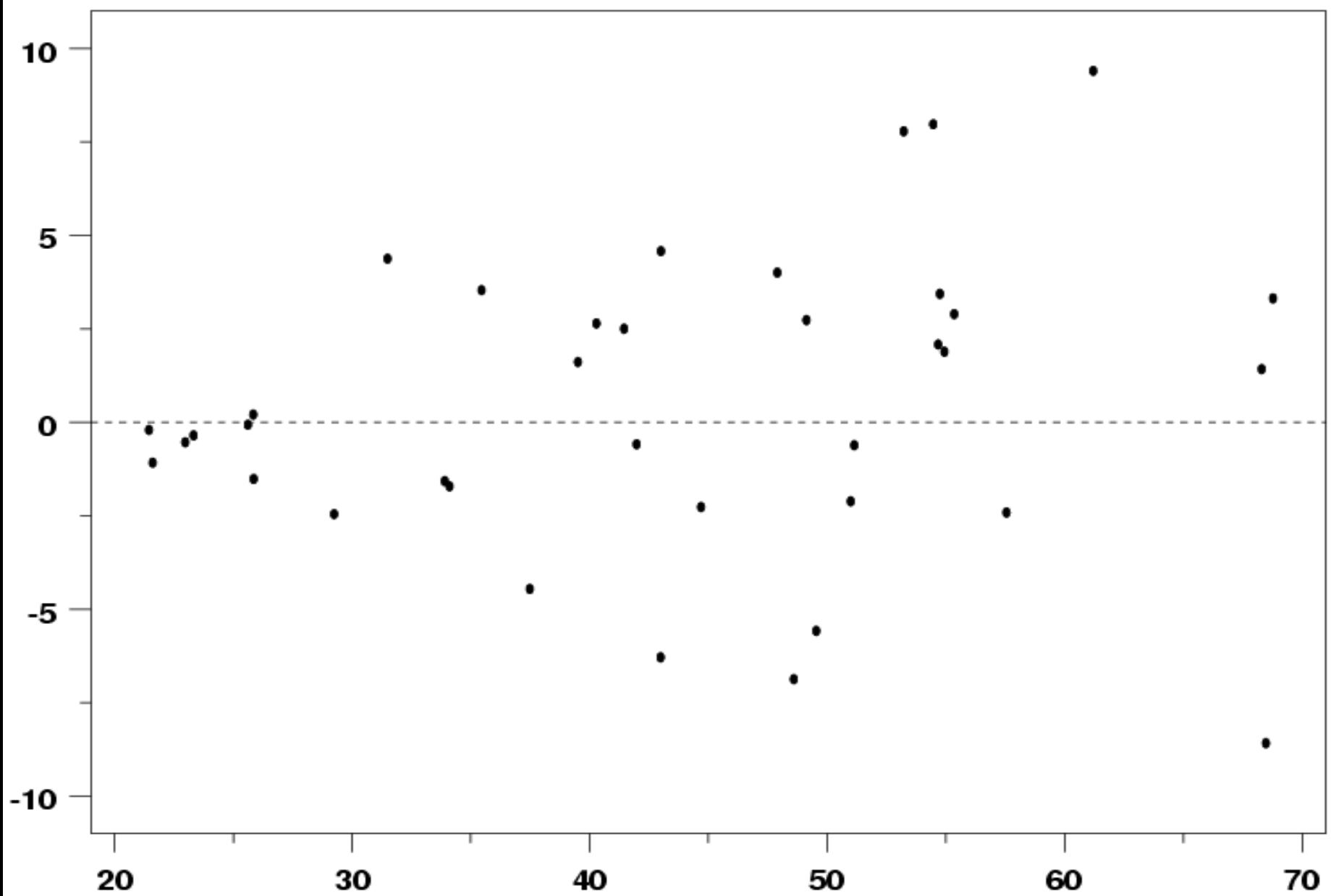


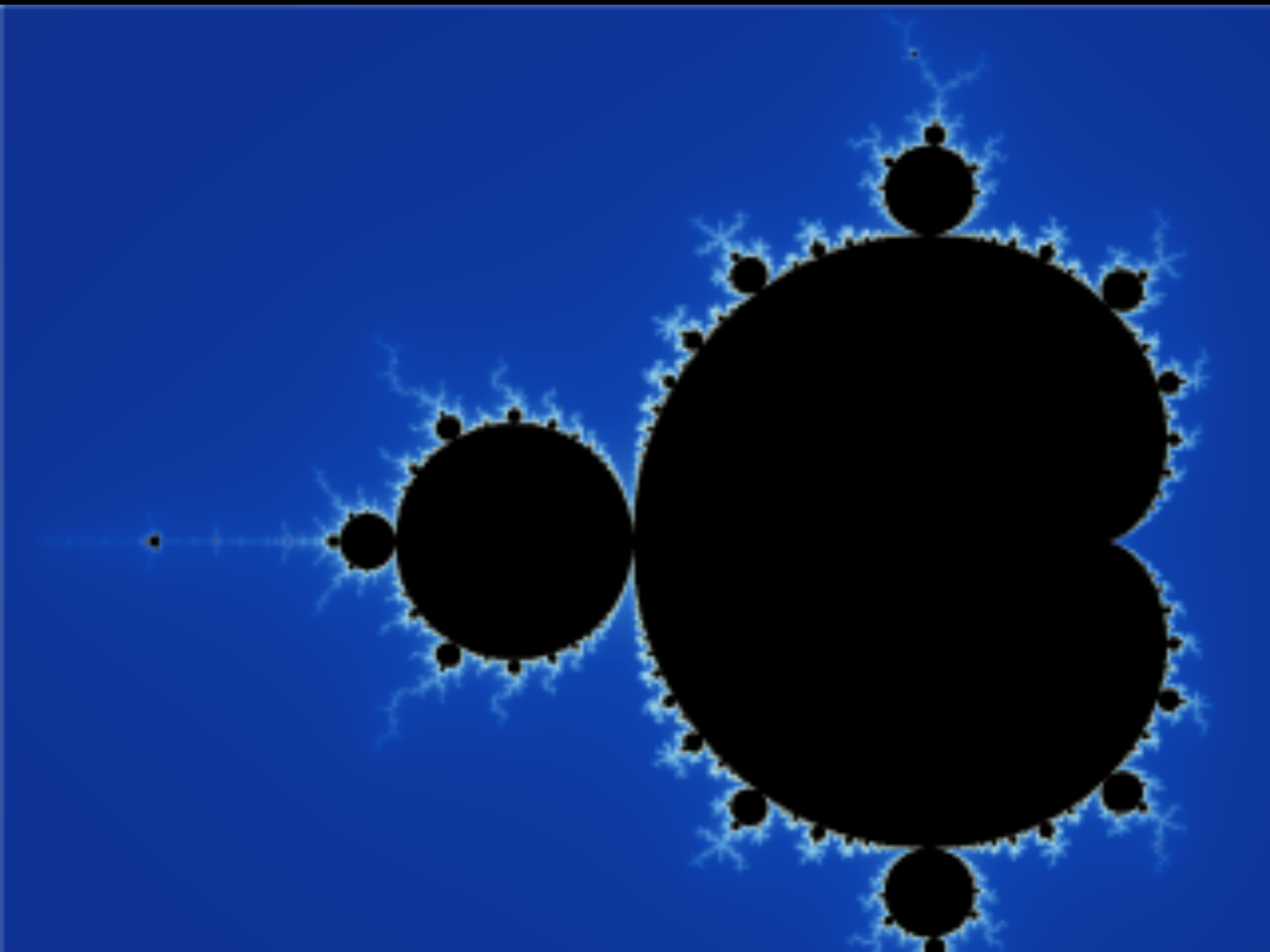












2. My response is to
