## Luke 1:26-38







1. The coming of Jesus Christ into the world taught Mary that nothing is beyond God's power, and He will do what it takes to accomplish what He promised. 1:37




God can accomplish or do anything because He is **omnipotent** (all-powerful), **omniscient** (all-knowing), and **omnipresent** (present everywhere, in all places at all times).




