






## 1. I am called to recognize the truth about Jesus and myself.




Finding himself in the presence of the divine made Simon Peter realize and confess his own sinfulness.

2. I am called to a transformed life in which I move from being a sinner to being a partner with Jesus in his mission.




Simon Peter's life was transformed so that he was no longer simply a professional fisherman, he was a fisherman who was working for Christ's purposes on earth.
