The centurion understood and trusted in the power and authority of Jesus.

Recognizing Jesus' authority, the centurion humbly asks for help he and his servant do not deserve.

Do I trust in the power, authority, and compassion of Jesus Christ enough to ask for help and throw myself completely on his mercy?

2. The centurion believed Jesus had the authority and desire to help people of all races, cultures, backgrounds, and economic levels.

Faith Luke 7:1-10 God's kingdom reflects God's love and acceptance of all racial, cultural, and economic backgrounds. All are wanted and welcome.

The Jews and Gentiles in this text show us that in God's kingdom people of different races and backgrounds can work together for a greater good. It is Jesus who unites them together.

In Christ, people who have no other reason to work together apart from God's purposes can minister to those who are suffering.

Who are those I knowingly or unknowingly exclude from my small part of God's kingdom and work?
