be careful who I
follow, because the
student becomes
like the teacher, 6:40**

**Jesus warns me to
evaluate and address
my own spiritual
issues before I
evaluate and help
others. 6:41-42**

**Have I made Jesus
Christ my teacher,
my guide, or am I
leading myself and
others astray?**

2. What do my words,
thoughts, and deeds
reveal about the
content of my heart
and character? 6:43-45



**Over time, my life
reveals who and
what I truly am.**

Fruit Inspectors do not inspect the fruit of individual moments in life but a pattern of walking with God over time.

**Fruit Inspectors do
not claim to be
certain of what is in
someone's heart but
see enough to raise
good questions.**

**Fruit Inspectors
know that where the
Spirit is at work
there will be at least
some fruit,
especially love.**

**Am I allowing Jesus
to transform who I
am, my character?**

3. Do I live according
to the word of the
Lord I have
received? 6:46-49



Wisdom is found to be present or absent in my life based on how I respond to the word of the Lord. Responding with words of honor and respect for Jesus is insufficient. I am to obey God's word.

**I must take seriously
the authority of
Jesus' teachings
and act on them. Not
to do so could be
devastating now and
forever.**

**Does my sincere
worship of Jesus
result in faithful
obedience to his
words?**
