







1. Jesus reveals that  
God's kingdom is present  
in his ministry through his  
power and authority over  
supernatural powers of  
evil. 11:14-23




The visible  
demonstrations of Jesus'  
power and authority force  
me to decide what I  
believe about who Jesus  
is and what his life and  
ministry mean to me and  
to the world. 11:14-20

Jesus is the strong one  
who overtakes the enemy  
and divides the spoils. I  
cannot remain neutral  
about Jesus. I either live  
under his power and  
authority, or I am in  
opposition to it. 11:21-23



What have I come to  
believe about who  
Jesus is and what he  
accomplished through  
his life, death, and  
resurrection?

**2. Jesus' life and mission reveals that God has moved things into the endgame. Now is the time to respond to Jesus. 11:24-36**



Jesus warns of the danger of experiencing God's work but leaving one's spiritual condition unfilled with anything from God. This could result in a worse spiritual condition. 11:24–26

Jesus emphasizes the  
importance of obeying,  
or living out, his  
teachings. 11:27-28

Jesus says our world has received all the proof, or signs, it is going to receive. God has revealed enough for us to have faith and trust in Jesus. Judgment awaits those who do not believe.


11:29-32

Jesus calls us to respond  
to the light. I am to allow  
light to shine in my life so  
I will know and live by  
God's truth, and so I will  
draw others out of  
darkness and into the  
light of life. 11:33-36

*The Allied strategy was to conquer North Africa, then move to Sicily and "up the boot" toward Berlin. Once Italy had been secured the "Invasion of Normandy" commenced on D-Day (June 6, 1944)*
