severe. 17:1–3a

God holds me

others into sin, and the  
consequences are dire. I

2. Disciples of Jesus  
share mutual  
accountability for  
correction,  
forgiveness, and  
restoration. 17:3b-4

Repentant sinners  
are to be forgiven  
and restored. 17:3c





This process is to  
repeat itself  
indefinitely. 17:4
