Am I joyfully building my life on the reality of God's presence?


2. My thankfulness is seen in how I tell of God's greatness among all the peoples of the world.

But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name. John 20:31


I am to remember His judgments.
