# The Candle of HOPE

Unto Us a Child is Born Isaiah 9:1-7

1. The birth of Jesus means that God and His grace come to me in the darkness of my life and circumstances.



God's people chose to go their own way rather than God's way; to trust in themselves and in foreign powers rather than trust in God. Thus, the nation was in darkness.

#### God promises that just as these people have experienced grief and despair, they will also experience joy (9:3-5).

Leaving Nazareth, he went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun and Naphtali—to fulfill what was said through the prophet Isaiah: "Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the way to the sea, along the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles—the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned." Matthew 4:13-17

God wants to give hope and a certain future to people who don't deserve it, to those who lost hope due to circumstances outside their control.



Whether I am a willful sinner, or I am in darkness due to circumstances outside my control, I should look for Jesus to come to me in my darkness where he will shine his light.

### I will come to know God's great, passionate love for me when I come to know Jesus Christ.


God will come to the aid of His children. He will come with power and great passion! He will act and make things right.
